

RESOLUTION NO. 13-1

A Resolution to Provide Support for the Central Illinois Economic Development Authority

WHEREAS, employment and business growth are critical to the economic vitality of Sangamon County and the quality of life of its residents; and

WHEREAS, the promotion of industrial, commercial, residential, service, transportation, and recreational activities and facilities in Central Illinois will encourage economic vitality and employment growth in the County; and

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois has recognized the importance of promoting the growth of these activities and facilities in our region of the State by creating the Central Illinois Economic Development Authority (CIEDA) through Public Act 94-995; and

WHEREAS, the counties of Calhoun, Christian, DeWitt, Greene, Jersey, Logan, Macon, Macoupin, Menard and Montgomery have joined with Sangamon as part of the CIEDA; and

WHEREAS, the 11 partnering counties that direct the activities of the Central Illinois Economic Development Authority and derive benefits from it have determined that its activities require shared funding for its work to go forward; and

WHEREAS, the Sangamon County Board wishes to assist in the work of the Central Illinois Economic Development Authority by providing a small amount of financial support for its efforts and activities;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, this 8th day of June, 2010, that the Sangamon County Board finds that \$1,500.00 should be provided to the Central Illinois Economic Development Authority from the County's Misc. Funds to assist CIEDA in its current activities.
